Quotation for the Printing and Delivery of Brochures for the Tourism and Economic Development Directorate

Reference is made to the above-mentioned quotation, for which the deadline for submission was originally set for 16th March 2018, at 10:00a.m. Kindly find hereunder clarifications which are construed to form part of the Quotation Document;

Clarification Number 1

Extension of Deadline

The deadline for requests for clarifications from the Contracting Authority is being extended till **Wednesday 14th March 2018 at noon**. Last date on which additional information is issued by the Contracting Authority will be extended up to **Friday 16th March 2018 at Noon**.

Please note that the closing date has been **extended and set to close on Wednesday 21st March 2018 at 10:00a.m.**

Clarification Number 2

Questions:

1. With reference to the Technical Specifications of the above mentioned requested for quotation, may we point out that the quality of paper being requested is stated as "gloss uncoated 140gsm paper". This statement is a contradiction as uncoated paper, which is the "cartridge" type paper used in everyday desktop printers, is in itself a very rough surfaced paper and can never be gloss. We need to have it clarified whether the contracting authority needs "gloss coated paper" or else "uncoated paper", which are 2 substrates completely different from each other.
2. Please can you specify the quality of the paper? It is not clear if it is requested a gloss or uncoated 140gsm paper. Gloss is one thing and uncoated paper is another. Please specify. (Section 4 - Technical Specifications (Note 3) (Pg 13))



3. May you kindly clarify if the quality of paper for brochures should be gloss or uncoated.

Answer:

With respect to **Section 4 – Technical Specifications**, for both the **General Brochure (A)** and the **Exhibition Brochure (B)** the **Quality of the Paper (3)** should be **gloss coated 140gsm paper**.

All other quotation documents, conditions and requirements, which are not superseded by these Clarifications, remain in place.
