Clarification

Question 1: Reference is made to your recent clarification response i.e. that dated 11th November [No. 3], specifically the following:- "It is estimated that less than 1 ton of oily waste is to be disposed annually.". 1 ton of oily waste is equivalent to 75kg monthly or 2.75 kilos daily. In view of this, and to ensure a competitive bid, whilst providing the cheapest cost/price possible for the Contracting Authority, will the Contracting Authority accept that the skips for Oily Waste are emptied only on a monthly basis (i.e. once a month)?

This is because, the costs associated with the tipping, disposal, handling and transportation per collection of oily waste is considerably higher when compared to the other types of waste.

That will provide a clear cost forecast for any bidder.

Answer 1: Answer to below clarification has been previously answered in Clarification 2 Question 2. Please note that if skip for oily waste is empty then there is no need to empty it.

All other tender documents, conditions and requirements, which are not superseded by this Clarification, remain in place.
